PCC UPDATE

Our PCC [the council of Trustees that oversees the Church Councils of both CtK and HTC] has a vacancy for PCC Secretary. This important role is a bit like a Company Secretary, rather than a minute-taking secretary, working with Paul to oversee the Agendas and distribute papers and agendas, responsible for keeping on top of the legal and constitutional basis of our councils. DCC UPDATE

Mission Support: The DCC affirmed their three-year Mission Support commitment to Jimmy Rocks [Florianopolis -in Brazil/CMS], David Burgess [India/EMI], Crisis Centre. We also agreed to continue to support, this year, with smaller amounts, Open Doors, Love Russia and Know Your Bible. We also made a commitment to ensure that each of these people and agencies would receive a higher profile in the coming year in our shared life, so we can support them more effectively in prayer.
