## PCC UPDATE

**Mission Support:** The DCC affirmed their three-year Mission Support commitment to Jimmy Rocks [Florianopolis -in Brazil/CMS], David Burgess [India/EMI], Crisis Centre. We also agreed to continue to support, this year, with smaller amounts, Open Doors, Love Russia and Know Your Bible. We also made a commitment to ensure that each of these people and agencies would receive a higher profile in the coming year in our shared life, so we can support them more effectively in prayer.
