NEW BISHOP OF BRISTOL

The Very Revd Vivienne Faull, currently Dean of York, has been appointed as the 57th Bishop of Bristol. Speaking at the Barton Hill Settlement in Bristol following the announcement, Viv said: "This is where my family comes from, and so coming here feels like I am returning home. "It was 24 years ago that Bristol was the first diocese to ordain women as priests, and I want the Diocese to continue to show that pioneering courage. Viv will be consecrated Bishop at a service at St Paul's Cathedral on 3 July and installed as Bishop of Bristol at Bristol Cathedral in the autumn.
